Top Tips to Planning an Affordable and Successful Group Retreat

SUCCESS – Make your planning a breeze by calling our experience Group Coordinator, Miranda Alexander at (864) 482 0453 groups@wildwaterltd.com to arrange your activities, meals and lodging. Check for group information at http://wildwaterrafting.com/groups/.

SUCCESS – Set a firm deadline for payment due and share Wildwater's cancellation policy with your group members. Payments can be made individually or by Group Leader over the telephone, online or by mailing a check or money order. We accept all major cards.

SUCCESS – Put together a trip packet for each group member with information such as where you are staying, which river you're rafting and additional activities you will be doing. Wildwater is happy to provide you with as many brochures as you need. This will alleviate a lot of repeat questions from group members. Include a blank waiver form for each activity in your information packets (can be downloaded, emailed or faxed) so that minors can have their legal guardians sign before the trip begins. Having everyone sign waivers prior to your trip time (youth and adults) will make check in a quicker process.

SUCCESS – Include the Best Dressed Rafter checklist of necessary gear in your information packet along with Reservation and Cancellation Policy information for all members.

SAVE – Raft on Weekdays (including many Sunday trips). We usually have lower rates for both rafting and some accommodations weekdays compared to weekends. Adding lodging to 2 or more activities can save your group even more! Your group can also take advantage of discounted packages and pre-formed packages.
